Enrolments

Enrolments are taken
from March to July each
year. Four-year-old
preschool children must
be four by April 30 in
their pre-school year and

three-year-olds must be
three by April.

Fees are kept to a
minimum and are set
annually by the committee
of management. We offer
free or low-cost four-year-
old kinder programs to
eligible children.

Early Start Programs

We offer Early Start
Programs to eligible
children who are
Aboriginal and/or Torres
Strait Islander, or are in
Child Protection. Children
must turn three before
April 30 in their pre-
school year.

LEARNING THROUGH PLAY



Attending preschool is the start of your child's formal education.

It's a time when they develop their basic skills, knowledge and attitudes. At the Coinda and Marrang preschools, we plan a program for each child's unique stage of development. They can learn at their own pace, whilst being challenged and gaining confidence along the way.

The safe, supervised learning atmosphere allows the children to

freely express themselves, take initiative and extend their imagination.

Wherever possible, the children's ideas are integrated into further learning experiences. At all times they are encouraged to show respect for their peers and property.

LEARNING THROUGH PLAY



At Coinda and Marrang preschools, children will learn:

Identity

Children feel safe, secure and supported. They learn to interact in relation to others, with care, empathy and respect.

Community

Children develop a sense of belonging to groups and are aware of fairness and respect for their peers and the environment.

Wellbeing

Children develop independent social, hygiene and safety skills.

Learning

Children explore, develop imagination, solve problems, co-operate, create and research and develop confidence.

Communication

Children interact verbally and non-verbally. Oral and written communication skills develop through music, singing, stories, dramatic play and sharing ideas.
